## Rebuilding Together Program

### Policy

PANC promotes the support of those with Parkinson's disease. As such, PANC offers monetary subsidies for the installation of health and safety items in their homes. These services are provided exclusively by Rebuilding Together and, each year, PANC will designate a budgetary amount that can be used for this purpose.

### Procedure

1. Individuals with PD may apply once per 12 month period for support.
2. Applicants must provide a physician's note to PANC stating the individual has PD.
3. Applicants must reside in Sacramento to obtain Rebuilding Together's services.
4. Applicant must be able to assist with communications and meetings with Rebuilding Together.
5. PANC will notify the applicant and Rebuilding Together of the approval of eligibility.
6. The PD individual (or caregiver) must contact Rebuilding Together directly to arrange for an in-home assessment and subsequent services.
7. Rebuilding Together will provide the services (ramps, poles, grab bars, etc.) up to the monetary value of the PANC subsidy. (If the amount of the service exceeds the value of the PANC voucher, Rebuilding Together will either absorb the cost for low income candidates or bill the client who is able to pay.)
8. Rebuilding Together will bill PANC.
9. The Rebuilding Together subsidy value should be used within six months of its approval
